### **Page 3, second paragraph, should be:**

“Sweden has a tradition of monitoring and reporting data on beef cattle into a national database (Taurus, 2012a). In May 2012 the database for beef breeds was shifted to become part of the system for dairy cattle. This resulted in the old PC-program for beef breeds, PC-KAP, to be replaced by the dairy cow computer system, KKPC, which today incorporates both the beef and dairy breeds. Today the organisation responsible for the cattle breeding evaluation in Sweden is Växa Sverige (Carlén, 2013, personal communication). In 2011 there was about 20 000 cows registered in PC-KAP, of which 12 000 were purebred (Svensk Mjök, 2012a).”
